

# 4-H Horse Show

## **RULES:**

1. Member must have attended at least 3 project meetings to be eligible to show.
2. 4-H members must be in good standing and enrolled in 4-H clubs located in Napa County. 4-H Club members may enroll with the Cooperative Extension Agency at age 9 as of January 1st and may continue to exhibit as a member of 4-H until the end of the calendar year in which the member becomes 19 years of age.
3. You must show your owned or leased project horse in your respective showmanship class in order to compete in any other classes. If you are late and miss the showmanship class, you will not be able to show in any other classes.
4. Required attire: 4-H or FFA uniform: tie or collar, belt, long sleeve white shirt, white or black pants, Western or English Boots and an ASTM/SEI approved helmet.
5. Member's Age for showing purposes will be as of January 1, 2009.
6. No riding double will be permitted anywhere on the grounds.
7. The judge may disqualify any animal that is not gentle enough to be shown safely. No awards will be made to any animal which shows visible evidence of disease or lameness.
8. No Stallions allowed.
9. Exhibitors are required to care for, prepare for showing and show their own animals.
10. Walk-Trot for beginner riders and/or horse only. No age break down, not permitted to cross enter classes except showmanship in the appropriate age division.
11. All classes will be given the required 3 minute notification.
12. Classes with less than 3 entries will be combined.
13. Inhumane treatment of any animal will be grounds for eviction from the park. Entry Fees will not be refunded.
14. **NO Post Entries.**
15. All dogs must be on leash at all times.
16. Showmanship exhibitors who place first in the Napa Town & Country Fair Horse Show are qualified and expected to participate with their horse in the Round Robin event held at the Napa Town & Country Fair on Friday, August 14th.
17. Juniors will be defined as 13 years of age or under. Seniors will be defined as 14 years of age and older.
  - 🏆 Division I - Ages 16 - 19
  - 🏆 Division II - Ages 12 - 15
  - 🏆 Division III - Ages 9 - 11
16. Horses are not allowed inside the log barrier.

Unless other rules are specified, rules and definitions for conducting each judged class as contained in the current AQHA Rule Book and for each gymkhana class as contained in the CA Horseman's Assoc. Rule Book will apply to all 4-H Horse Shows. Decisions of the Judge/Show Management are Final.
